Fundraising Updates and Opportunities

We are always looking for fundraising opportunities to especially help the new parents and students earn money for their band account. If you have any fundraising ideas, please let any of the Board members know.

- Yankee Candle: Orders and money are due tonight. Make sure your orders and money match. Please put everything in an envelope with your student's name.
- Golf Tournament: Rescheduled due to weather for **Saturday, April 28th at Hampton Creek Golf Course**. If you know anyone that golfs or would like to sponsor a hole, please let Cliff Dockery or Jeff Neeley know as soon as possible.
- Car Wash: **April 28th from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Southeast Bank**
We need more parents and students to help at the car wash as we will have to split up since the golf tournament will be going on at the same time.

We ask that each student sell at least 10 tickets (preferably more☺) for each Car Wash. Tickets are available up front. Tickets are a \$5.00 donation. This money goes into your student's band account

- All money needs to be turned in an envelope with the student's name on the front so we will know which student's band account to credit

May Band Booster meeting date has changed and it will now be held on May 15th. This meeting is for both students and parents. Paperwork is due that evening. Go to website at: www.ooltewahband.org to print the paperwork. Two documents need to be notarized. We will try and have a notary at the May meeting, but you may want to visit your local bank to get the forms notarized to save time. We will also measure for shoes and warm-ups at this meeting. A \$150 non-refundable deposit will also be due when you turn in your paperwork to ensure your student has a spot written into this year's marching show.

Band Accounts: Please keep in mind that any money that is credited into your child's band account, we cannot give a refund. The Booster organization is a 501c3 organization and to give a refund will jeopardize our non-profit status. Any money that is put into the account is consider a donation to the band program to support the program as a whole.

End of Year Band Party is May 4th at 6:30 in the OHS Commons. The Boosters will provide the main meal and the families will bring the sides and desserts. We will send a sign up sheet closer to the date. After dinner, we will head to the Little Theater to watch Senior Skits and the announcements of the awards. The students will head to the band room for a dance until 10:00 PM.

Mr. Denton

Welcome! The upcoming Band year will be exciting and will provide incredible opportunities to each student. We will provide Mr. Miller and Mrs. Coates with information on the upcoming Band season.

All State – Eight of the 11 students going to All State are from Ooltewah. We will be leaving later in the week to attend. Congratulations to those who made All State!

Budget Presentation

Mr. Denton is presenting the budget, but he does not vote. He has provided an actual vs. estimated view of last year's budget so we can see where we ended up and how it compares to this year's suggested budget. We still have \$35K - \$40K in outstanding fees. We hope that anyone with outstanding fees continues to pay them and the Golf Tournament will help us make up the difference.

We will not be attending any competitions this year. Our hope is to use this year's show to build upon for next years. There will be one marching band. We will perform at all Football games and will take the entire band to the East Hamilton game. We will take a Pep Band to attend some of the away games. After school rehearsals will be as follows: Monday – Concert Band; Tuesday and Thursday – Marching Band. There will be a trip this year in the Fall. Money will be collected by Gateway. If a student does not pay, then they cannot attend. There will be a 10% reduction in fee if the entire amount is paid by July.

Several questions were asked and answered by Mr. Denton in regards to instructional expenses and travel consultants.

Motion to accept the budget as is: 1st motion made by Michele Steves; 2nd motion made by Stafford Turner. All band booster members approved. No objections.

This year we have several amazing opportunities. Band fees must be paid to be eligible. We have several fundraising opportunities available that will allow you to make money for your student's band account and to pay by July.

Snap-raise will be at next month's meeting in May. All students need to do is bring in 20 contacts. We have the potential to make \$38k in a week.

McDonald's Thanksgiving Parade (Chicago, IL) – Thanksgiving

We have been accepted to march in the McDonald's Thanksgiving Parade in Chicago, IL. We will be gone Tuesday thru Sunday. The students will be on WGN TV. Plans are to re-use our Santa costumes.

We have a great hotel lined up with several breakfasts included. We will have Thanksgiving Dinner in a boat on Lake Michigan. The students will have an opportunity to do some Black Friday shopping. We will also go to the 360 Observation Deck, Navy Pier and other landmarks. We will see Hamilton one evening and attend the Chicago Symphony as they play Star Wars music. **The cost for (students only) will be \$1,150 per student (four to a room).** First payment will be due in June. Trip payments will be made to Gateway.

Mr. Denton has approached Mrs. Copp and the Superintendent about obtaining some instructional help this coming year. To be able to accomplish this, Mr. Denton will need to retire, but working out details of a 120 day contract. They will bring in the new Band Director (job will be posted on the HCDE website). This may mean that we will have to rely on less outside instructional support that could potentially reduce fees.

Congratulations to Mr. Denton on his CMA award. Presentation of the award is May 8th.
